Yokohama City Action Plan for Promoting Local Japanese Language Education (draft) [Summary Version]

The purpose of plan-making

In order to further enhance the local Japanese language education (learning support) environment unique to Yokohama in response to the increase in the number of foreign residents and changes in their Japanese language learning needs, this plan was formulated to grasp the actual situation and needs for Japanese language learning support in the city area, and to promote efforts toward multiculturalism in cooperation with related organizations and citizens, including foreign residents, in the future.

Period: Roughly 5 years from FY2025 to FY2029

To be reviewed as necessary based on changes in the social environment and trends in systems and related plans.

Basic Concept

Philosophy

To promote a multicultural community through seamless Japanese language learning support for children and adults.

Vision of the Community

Through communication in Japanese, foreigners and Japanese people deepen mutual understanding and live together as members of society while trying to build equal relationships.

Direction of measures

Measures will be promoted based on the following three directions.

The direction of the measures 1: Ensure and enhance opportunities for learning Japanese The direction of the measures 2:

Support and cultivate local

Japanese language supporters

The direction of the measures 3: Strengthen cooperation with each entity

Specific actions to realize the measures (Action Plan)

The direction of the measures 1: Ensure and enhance opportunities for learning Japanese.

In the city, there are many efforts to support learning, centering on local Japanese classes, but with the increase in the number of foreign residents, learning needs are increasing and diversifying. To provide Japanese language learning opportunities that meet the needs of students in terms of accessibility and purpose, in cooperation with local Japanese language education specialists, etc., so that students can choose where to study, and to improve the Japanese language learning environment, and to enhance the collection and provision of information.

The direction of the measures 2: Support and cultivate local Japanese language supporters

As the need for Japanese language learning expands, Japanese language institutions and local Japanese language classes are facing the challenge of fostering and securing supporters who provide learning support. In order to enable a variety of supporters who can respond to individual learning objectives to participate and play an active role in learning support, approach to foster and secure supporters of local Japanese language education in cooperation with International Lounges, local Japanese language classes, local residents, and involved-foreigners.

The direction of the measures 3: Strengthen cooperation with each entity

In order to respond to diversifying needs for Japanese language learning, it is necessary to share issues with each entity and strengthen cooperation toward solutions. To further enhance the adjustment and coordination function by assigning

coordinators to the "Yokohama Nihongo Support Center", which is the promotion base for this project, and is going to support the establishment of a system of cooperation and collaboration with each entity.

Promotion structure

To arrange a promotion system centered on Yokohama City, Yokohama Association for International Communications and Exchanges and the "Yokohama Nihongo Support Center" (hereinafter referred to as "the Center") and promote local Japanese education with related organization involved in local Japanese language education (learning support), including International lounges, organizations that operate local Japanese language classes, Japanese language institutions(Japanese language schools, etc.), Japanese language teacher training institutions, businesses, and local organizations.

Yokohama City

By the International Affairs Bureau playing a central role, promote the creation of a comprehensive local Japanese language education system through cross-departmental collaboration. To work with relevant bureaus such as the Ward Office for international lounges, cooperation with local organizations and provision of information to foreign residents, the Economic Affairs Bureau for cooperation with businesses, the Board of Education for Japanese language education for children, and the Child and Youth Bureau for support for foreign parents raising their children.

● Yokohama Association for International Communications and Exchanges(YOKE)

As a core organization involved in local Japanese language education and multiculturalism, it functions as the "Yokohama Nihongo Support Center" and provides comprehensive coordination in the Yokohama City area, including understanding the needs and situation of Japanese language education for foreign residents, and demonstrating coordination and networking among various entities.

● Yokohama Nihongo Support Center (YNC)

The Center has two roles: "a base to promote the creation of a comprehensive local Japanese language education system" and "a base to support foreign residents in learning Japanese", and carries out each of these activities. The Center functions as a base by establishing a general coordination council and assigning coordinators.

Establishment of the General Coordination Council

At the experts' meeting consisting of the international associations, experts in various fields such as local Japanese language education and multiculturalism, and representatives from local Japanese language classes, Japanese language schools, businesses, and foreign residents, etc., results and issues in the project will be shared, information from various fields will be shared and discussed. The council will also manage the progress of the project and confirm the achievement of its goals.


Assignment of general coordinators and local Japanese language education coordinators

To promote local Japanese language education by coordinating and cooperating with necessary related organizations, providing advice to Japanese language classes in the area, building a network of support-related organizations and groups, and providing outreach support such as assistance in creating Japanese language education programs.

International Lounges

Understanding the purpose of this Action Plan, and as part of its role as a center for multiculturalism and international exchange within the ward, provide information on Japanese language learning (support), operate Japanese language classes and provide operational support (such as providing venues and holding training courses), hold liaison meetings for Japanese language classes, foster Japanese language learning supporters, and so on.

[Local Japanese Language Classes]

- Local Japanese language classes provide a variety of support opportunities for foreign residents to live as a member of the community, including "a familiar place to the learn Japanese language necessary for daily life," "a place to understand the structure of the Japanese social system and to consult on daily life," and "a place to meet and interact with other residents living in the same community. These activities are the result of local residents' initiative based on their mutual support, and are indispensable for the promotion of multiculturalism in Yokohama.
- Local Japanese language classes provide an opportunity to grasp various issues closely related to daily life, in addition to issues related to the acquisition of Japanese. While valuing the autonomy of each local Japanese language class, it is important to share issues with a wide range of entities and link them to support for foreign residents so that local Japanese language classes do not hold onto the issues they have grasped.

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
